ETIQUETTE & POLICIES

SHOWING RESPECT FOR THEMSELVES:

- Students should arrive early for class for light stretching and preparation. Students should not sit on the floor unless they are actively stretching.
- Young students should not be left unattended prior to the beginning of class.
- Female students are required to wear designated class attire: black or blue leotards, pink or flesh tone tights (no leggings or panty hose), and pink ballet slippers. Panties should not be worn under leotard and tights.
- Male students should wear tights, biking shorts or shorts, a fitted t shirt or leotard, and black ballet slippers.
- Female students are required to have their hair groomed neatly in a bun.

DANCERS SHOW RESPECT TO OTHERS:

- Keeping their hands to themselves during their lesson.
- Waiting quietly for others to have their turn.
- Waiting until the music is finished before entering the classroom if student is late to class.
- Talking only when spoken to by instructor.

DANCERS SHOW RESPECT FOR THEIR TEACHER AND THE ART FORM THEY ARE LEARNING:

- Being properly dressed and ready for class.
- Listening when the instructor speaks.
- Being prepared for his/her turn.
- Always asking before leaving the room for any reason.
- Applauding or bowing to their instructor at the end of class.
- Students will not be allowed to participate in classes for which they have arrived more than fifteen minutes late. They will be asked to observe the class from the front of the studio.
- Level and class placement is based on student's level of training.
- Students are expected to maintain consistent attendance in all classes in which they are enrolled in order to progress to the next level. Students are advised to make up missed classes in a level lower or level designated by his/her instructor.
- Female students will be evaluated for pointe shoes at the age of 11 years. There are age exceptions to this rule. Please do not take the initiative in placing your child en pointe without evaluations/supervision. Techniques will not place any student en pointe until all preparatory goals have been met.

GUARDIANS/PARENTS SHOW RESPECT FOR THE DANCE CLASS, TEACHER, AND STUDIO:

- Parents should remain outside the studio while their child's class is in session. Due to limited space and weather conditions this is a difficulty and is not strictly enforced and is understandably difficult at times.
- Please avoid being a distraction during class, again due to limited space and weather conditions this is at times unavoidable.
- Prompt retrieval of your child will ensure his/her safety. Students are asked to remain in the school and not outdoors while waiting for rides. No young students will be allowed to exit the facility without a guardian/parent.
- Only registered students are allowed in class/studio. Please no siblings as observers unless they are potential students.
- Techniques for the most part follows the inclement weather school closing policy.
- Parents/guardians must agree to terms before each child may participate in classes.
